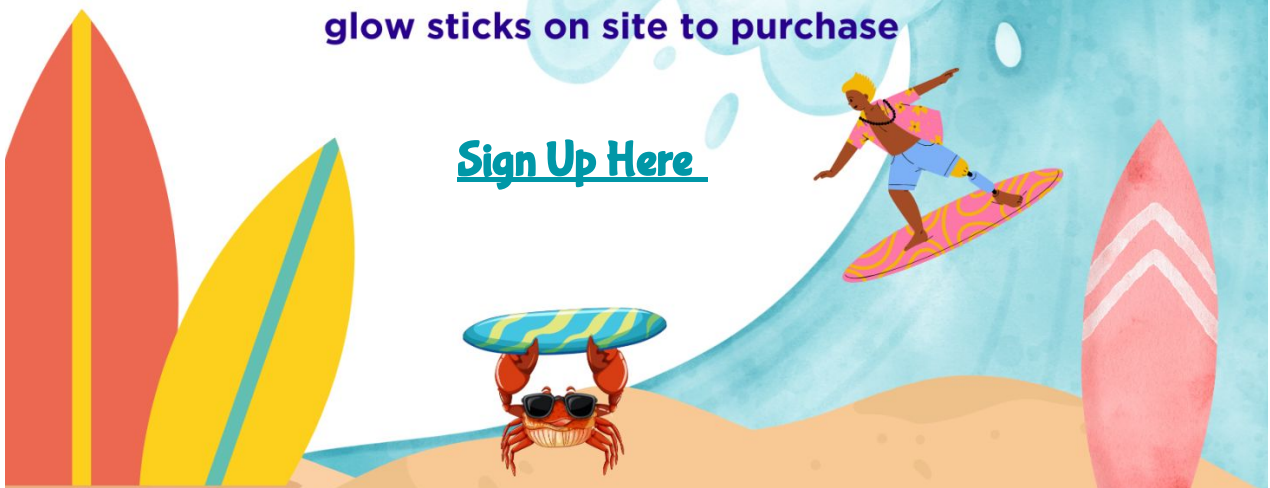

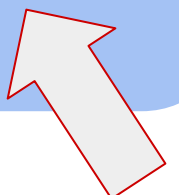

WELLNESS INITIATIVE

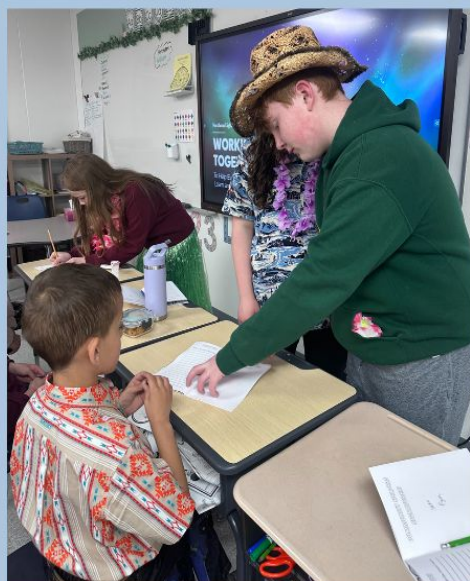
